Nominations for Upcoming Annual Meeting

This year we have two positions each for the Board of Directors, Supervisory Committee and Credit Committee. If you are interested in serving the Credit Union in a voluntary position, please contact 759.1686 ext. 425; no later than February 1, 2019.

Board of Directors – The Board of Directors governs the operations of the Credit Union. They approve the rates of interest that are charged on loans to members and approve the terms and dividend rates paid on deposits.

Supervisory Committee – The Supervisory Committee performs a monthly review of new accounts and loans for all offices. They are also responsible to make, or cause to be made, a comprehensive financial audit of the Credit Union's financial records at least annually and must report the results of the financial audit to the members at the Annual Meeting.

Credit Committee – The Credit Committee performs a review of loans that have been approved by Loan Officers or by the Loan Committee. They are also responsible for documenting all of the loan activities of the credit union.

IRA Update

The Treasury Department has increased the 2019 IRA contribution limit to \$6,000. The catch-up amount for those 50 years & older remains at \$1,000. Remember, you have until April 15, 2019 to make 2018 IRA contributions. Stop in and open your IRA Savings or Certificate of Deposit today!

To use mobile banking, you must be registered for online banking with Netbranch. Using your FFCU login ID and your password used for Netbranch you can log in, check transaction history, transfer money, make a loan payment, apply for a loan & much more; right from your phone. Be in control of your finances by setting up eAlerts to inform you when your balance is low, when your FFCU loan payment is due, when checks have cleared or the transactions being held waiting to process.
