### Lost your card or suspect fraudulent use?

You can lock the card on our mobile app to prevent the transactions from going through.

#### **Notifications**

Get alerts instantly after a transaction was complete with location and amount.

#### **Transaction Limits**

Allows you to set spending parameters, including how much you can spend, blocking in-store purchases outside of your area and enable/restrict international transactions.

## Unexpected PDF Delivery

Cybercriminals are sending emails with PDF attachments that look like they're from trusted companies like Microsoft or PayPal. The message may claim there's an issue with your account and urge you to call a customer service number.

subscriptions or latest tech gadgets are examples of wants, things that aren't necessary for survival.

Try using 50/30/20 rule: spend 50% on needs, 30% on wants, and save 20%.

The PDF looks official—but it's a trap! The phone number connects you to a scammer who pretends to be support. They'll try to get you to install malware or share sensitive information.

Tip: Never call numbers from unexpected emails. Always verify through official websites or known contacts.


